

# **FASTENERS**

### These are the fasteners used in the assembly of Perfect Spaces Storage Systems:



Breakaway Screws (Gold / Silver)

When purchasing your first closet you will receive a supply of fasteners adequate to complete the installation of your storage system. On your next closet order you will need to include a parachute bag stocked with a supply of fasteners. Please see the "Parachute Bags & Fasteners" guide/video for details.


- Screws, fasteners and anchors (as found in your parachute bag)
- Level (use the longest one possible)
- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Tape Measure

- Power Drill
- Countersink Drill Bits
- #2 Square Drive Bit

Your island will have two island vertical panels along with a partition which forms the center spine of the island. Vertical panels will receive **Rafix connector studs**.



Identify the top and bottom of each vertical panel. The top will be banded, the bottom will not. Install a Rafix connector stud in **each top hole**, each **third** hole from the bottom, and **each center hole**.




Attach the partition to the panels by sliding the cams onto the studs and then turn clockwise to tighten.



Lower the top shelves into place and tighten them.




Install the toe kick onto the bottom shelves by lining up the toe kick on the underside of the bottom shelf so that it is flush on the edges and touching the rafix connector housing.




Then install 3" wood screws in the predrilled holes, being very careful not to over tighten them.



Install the bottom shelves by placing the rear cams on the rear studs and tighten them, then lower the front of the shelf until the front cams click into place.



Place your countertop on top of the island. Centered it so that there are reveals of 1/2" on the sides and 1" on the front and rear. Set your drill bit depth so that it does not go all the way through the countertop and pre-drill four holes from below, two on each side.



Fasten the countertop in place using 1-1/4" screws.
